## Re: Revised after-school pick-up times for Sri KL

In attempting to ease the traffic build-up out side the school, particularly during pick-up time in the afternoon, the School has revised the 2018 pick-up times for Primary and Secondary School. Kindly refer to the schedules below.

## PRIMARY SCHOOL

Daily Pick-up Time 3.30 PM to 4.00 PM

- Parents with children exclusively in Primary School are requested to arrive outside school NO EARLIER THAN 3.20 PM
- O Please note, if you do arrive earlier and plan to wait you may be asked to move on by the PDRM Traffic Police stationed outside or by the School's traffic marshals and this will cause you considerable inconvenience. Therefore, kindly time your arrival to match the time allotted above. *Drivers, chauffeurs, etc., please take note!*

## SECONDARY SCHOOL

Daily Pick-up Time 4.00 PM onwards

- Parents with children in Secondary School OR both schools are requested to arrive outside school NO EARLIER THAN 4.00 PM.
- O Please note, if you do arrive earlier and plan to wait you may be asked to move on by the PDRM Traffic Police stationed outside or by the School's traffic marshals and this will cause you considerable inconvenience. Therefore, kindly time your arrival to match the time allotted above. *Drivers, chauffeurs, etc., please take note!*
- Additionally, dear parents, you are requested to accustom your children to waiting on Persiaran Kewajipan after the bus stop and not directly in front of the school unless rainy weather does not permit.
