Re: Pick-up times for students at Sri KL

Firstly, may I take this opportunity to wish you all a very Happy New Year for 2019 and a warm welcome back to Sri KL.

Last year, as part of our transition to controlled entry and exit to and from the School compound, pick-up times for Primary and Secondary School were separated and different pick-up zones for the students were assigned. The effect was significantly improved traffic flow in and around the School. Therefore, we will be continuing with separate times and pick-up zones for 2019. Kindly refer to the schedules below.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

Daily Pick-up Time 3.30 PM to 4.00 PM

- Parents with children **exclusively in Primary School** are requested to arrive outside school **NO EARLIER THAN 3.30 PM**.
- Please note, if you do arrive earlier and plan to wait you will be asked to move on by the PDRM Traffic Police stationed outside or by the School's traffic marshals and this will cause you considerable inconvenience. Therefore, kindly time your arrival to match the time allotted above. *Drivers, chauffeurs, etc., please take note!*

SECONDARY SCHOOL

Daily Pick-up Time 4.00 PM onwards

- Parents with children in **Secondary School OR both schools** are requested to arrive outside school **NO EARLIER THAN 4.00 PM**.
- Please note, if you do arrive earlier and plan to wait you may be asked to move on by the PDRM Traffic Police stationed outside or by the School's traffic marshals and this will cause you considerable inconvenience. Therefore, kindly time your arrival to match the time allotted above. *Drivers, chauffeurs, etc., please take note!*
- Additionally, dear parents, you are requested to accustom your secondary school going children to waiting on *Persiaran Kewajipan* after the bus stop and not directly in front of the school unless rainy weather does not permit.

As mentioned last year, the School is taking steps to build a new covered walkway along *Persiaran Kewajipan* and also to upgrade the road and traffic flow in front of Sri KL. This will take some time to complete but, in the mean time, these arrangements will help to ease traffic congestion not just for Sri KL parents but also for the wider community using the roads around Subang Jaya.

Also, as previously mentioned in our circulars to parents, the School has implemented a new car sticker system whereby all stickers have an individual serial number. We hope this will increase safety and improve traffic flow by allowing us to track errant drivers and deter unauthorized parking in the School compound.

Therefore, I should like to remind all parents without stickers, intending to drive into the School compound, to obtain 2019 car stickers as soon as possible as enforcement against unauthorized entry will be stepped up after the first week of Semester One.

As such, your co-operation and your understanding in this matter are greatly appreciated.
