COVID-19 SITUATION AT SRI KL

UPDATE NO. 7

The government has announced a Restricted Movement Order covering all non-essential services in the country from 18<sup>th</sup> March to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. **Therefore, Sri KL School will be closed to students, parents and the general public for this period.**

As such,

- All co-curricular activities, inside or outside of the school, involving any number of students and staff, are suspended with immediate effect until further notice.
- The School's administration counter, bookshop and uniform shop are closed for all transactions during this period.
- Our previous quarantine directive for students and staff also remains in place. Therefore, students or students with family members in the same house who travel abroad anywhere outside of Malaysia over the holidays are subject to 14 days quarantine on return.
- The timetable for online classroom teaching is being finalized and student/parents will receive notification prior to lessons starting on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March via Google Classroom.
- It is expected that Primary School students will be online for a maximum of 3 hours a day, Monday to Friday and Secondary School students for a maximum of 4 hours a day.
- Lessons will be spread over the day from 8.30am to 3.00pm and structured such that Primary School lesson time will not overlap Secondary School lesson time. Students will be given suitable break time between lessons.
- Students are advised to prepare for the programme by having their textbooks and learning materials ready along with a suitable device such as a handphone, tablet or computer and a good internet connection.

To date there are still no reported cases of Covid-19 at Sri KL and a total of 9 students and 1 staff member remain under self-imposed quarantine.

We will continue to update parents as the situation develops.
