**COVID-19 SITUATION AT SRI KL**

**UPDATE No. 24**

**IGCSE EXAMINATIONS AT SRI KL**

- We wish to inform parents and students of Year 11 that the Ministry of Education has released a media statement, early this morning, to the effect that **students sitting for international examinations may sit for the exams on condition that they obtain a confirmation letter issued by their individual schools.**
- The media statement in this regard is brief but clearly indicates that students may travel to sit for their exams. There is no mention of any endorsement or approval being required from the police in this case.
- Therefore, it is our assumption that students traveling to and from exams will only need to carry confirmation letters from the School to show to police and other enforcement agencies in order to be exempted from the current CMCO which comes into effect at 12.00 midnight today.
- As such, we are preparing individual letter packages for each Y11 candidate containing a letter of confirmation from the School, a copy of the media statement from the MoE and also a support letter from Cambridge International Examinations.

Y11 Parents,

- Please arrange to collect your child's individual letter package from the main guardhouse between 12.00pm and 4.30pm today.
- Please bring this letter package with you at all times when traveling to and from exams.
- **DO NOT USE THIS LETTER TO TRAVEL ON ANY OTHER BUSINESS.**

Y11 Students,

- On the day of your exams, please arrive 45 minutes before your exam is due to start at the main pedestrian entry gate for a mandatory temperature check.
- You are reminded to attend exams in full school uniform with an approved type of face mask. **Please bring your original IC card and Statement of Entry.**
- You must at all times maintain social distancing before, during and after the examinations.
- Lunch will be provided for students sitting morning and afternoon papers.
- You should check your temperature before leaving home. Do not come to school if your temperature is above 37.4 degrees Celsius or if you are experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms.
- All the necessary steps will be taken to ensure the School premises and in particular the exam hall is fully sanitized and ready for you.
- Above all, stay calm and stay focused on your exams.
