COVID-19 SITUATION AT SRI KL

Update No. 45

Delayed return to Sri KL due to extended closure of all schools

- As you are no doubt aware, the government has declared that schools across the country will remain closed for **a further period beginning from the 14th June to the 16th of July.**
- As such, students will not be able to return to school on the 14th June for the start of Second Semester 2021. A briefing yesterday by the Private Education Department of the Ministry of Education (MoE) to all private schools has made it clear that there are no exceptions allowed including Year 11 students.
- Therefore, online classes will be scheduled to begin again on the 14th for all Year groups and continue until such time as the government decides when schools can reopen again for F2F classes.
- We will update parents as soon as we have any further information from MoE.

Sri KL 2020 Year 11 cohort's SPM results for delayed exams in 2021

- **The MoE has informed all schools that the results for last year's Y11 delayed SPM exams will be released tomorrow on Thursday 10th June after 10.00 A.M onwards.** However, in a break from the usual arrangement where our students come to school to obtain their results, the ministry has set up a remote system for this session. This is to maintain social distancing during the pandemic.
- Our 2020 Year 11 students have been given instructions on how to access their results from the official MoE website.
- Alternatively, students will also have received notice from the Secondary School informing them that the school will be emailing results to students once we have received and collated them.
- Wishing all our 2020 candidates the very best of luck.

- We are pleased to report that the mid-year examinations for Primary School were successfully completed online and that students from across all Year Groups were able to effectively participate with only a small number of minor issues arising. Thanks and well done to our students for your excellent attitude.

- The Secondary School mid-year exams will be held soon after the mid-year holidays and will be conducted on-line. Students are advised to prepare accordingly.

Lastly, we would like to remind everyone in the Sri KL community to avoid large family gatherings and to double mask up whenever out in public.
